- 1. Open to any individual amateur baker who is a Pennsylvania resident. One entry per person.
- 2. Entrants may NOT have won 1st place in this Blue Ribbon Apple Pie contest at any other fair in 2024.
- The Apple Pie, including fillings and crust, must be made from scratch with edible ingredients. No prepackaged ingredients may be used (ex: no pre-made mixes, cookie dough, pie crust, frosting, etc.) Any decorations must just be edible.
- Recipe must include at least 60% apples in the filling. It does not need to be a "traditional" two crusted apple pie and it can have a variety of fillings.
- The entire pie must be submitted for judging in a food safe disposable pie pan. (All pans, plates and dishes are considered to be disposable and will not be returned.)
- 6. The recipe for the pie and pie crust must be submitted with the entry. It should be submitted on one side of 8 ½" by 11" sheets of paper. The recipe must list all the ingredients, quantities, and the preparation instructions. Entrant's name, address and phone number must be printed on the back side of all the pages. (All recipes and pies will become the property of the Fair or PA Farm Show and will not be returned.)
- Refrigeration is not available at the Fair or PA Farm Show. Entries that require refrigeration after baking must indicate so in the recipe. Those entries will not be sold, auctioned or otherwise distributed for consumption after judging for food safety reasons.

Creativity is essential to a varied competition. Do not limit your contest to a "traditional" two-crusted apple pie. We are looking for a variety of fillings in the pies; the pie must include <u>at least 60% apples</u> in the filling.

Each Fair must submit the Contest Summary Report verifying the winning apple pie baker. This person will then be eligible to enter the state competition at the 2025 PA Farm Show and will receive the <u>Official PA Farm Show Certification Entry Form</u> directly from the PA Fairs Special Baking Contest Committee by December 2.

<u>NOTE</u>: If an individual has already won 1st place at another fair in 2024 for this Blue Ribbon Apple Pie contest, that individual is now considered qualified through that Fair to compete at the 2025 PA Farm Show and is no longer eligible to enter this contest at any upcoming Fairs.

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

3. Use standard mason type, clear quart, or pint glass jars for preserving and exhibiting fruits, vegetables, and meats. Half pints must be used for jams, jellies, and preserves.

4. Use 2-piece self- sealing lids (flat disc and metal screw bands) for sealing all jars of food.

5. Leave all rings (screw bands) on jars.

6. All canned food not in standard jars or not sealed with self-sealing lids will be disqualified.

7. Absolutely no entries will be accepted that have personalized labels on them.
