Pennsylvania Cattle Health Requirements:

- 1. A Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) issued after July 29, 2025 is required.
- 2. All animals must be free of infectious and contagious diseases.
- 3. The Exhibitor's signature on the Livestock Entry Form affirms that a veterinary-client-patient relationship is in place.
- 4. Individual official animal identification is required. Official ID includes:
- ☐ A USDA-issued metal ear tag; or
- ☐ A breed registration tattoo if the tattoo is legible and the animal is accompanied

by a copy of the registration certificate; or

- \sqcap A breed registration ear tag if the animal is accompanied by a copy of the registration certificate; or
- \sqcap An ISO-compliant 15-digit ear tag (including RFID).

13. Sr. 2-year-old born between 9/1/22 and 2/28/23

5. A current rabies vaccination administered by a licensed veterinarian is required for animals 3 months of age and older (*market cattle are exempt from this vaccination requirement*). All vaccine label directions must be followed, and all rabies vaccinated cattle must be accompanied by a rabies vaccination certificate or the vaccination information must be included on the CVI. If a rabies vaccination certificate is provided, the certificate must contain legible name and contact information of the veterinarian who administered the vaccine and the veterinarian's signature. A copy of the rabies vaccination certificate is acceptable.
