#### **Pennsylvania Camelid Requirements:**

- 1. A Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) issued after July 29, 2025 is required.
- All animals must be free of infectious and contagious diseases.
- 3. The Exhibitor's signature on the Livestock Entry Form affirms that a veterinaryclient-patient relationship is in place.
- 4. Individual animal identification is required. ID options include:
- Official ID, including:
- O An ISO-compliant 15-digit ear tag (including RFID); or
- O A state-approved tattoo; or
- O An electronic implant device (the exhibitor must supply a reader); or
- O A USDA-issued metal ear tag. or
- On the AAI-13 (Certificate of Veterinary Inspection form obtained from the Department of Agriculture) accredited veterinarians simply need to:
- I mark "Camelid" in box number 4;
- If write the animal's color in box number 8;
- record date of birth in box number 10;
- I record gender in box number 11; and
- I record either "llama" or "alpaca" in box number 12.
- \*In addition, veterinarians are encouraged to write down any distinguishing markings that are present on the animal. Questions regarding proper identification for camelids on Certificates of Veterinary Inspection for Pennsylvania fairs can be directed to Dr. Tony LaBarbera at 717-783-9550.
