Mission:

Members get a behind-the-scenes look at how the fair works, help promote agricultural education, participate in community service, and build real-world leadership and teamwork skills. Along the way, members make new friends, grow their creativity, and help shape a fun, memorable fair experience for everyone.

Requirements:

- Ages 13–20 as of January 1, 2026
- Parent/guardian approval required for minors
- Must attend a Middle School or High School in the county, reside in Beaver County, or be a member in good standing with a 4-H/FFA Club/Chapter/Scout Troop in Beaver County
- Ability to volunteer a minimum of 10 hours during Fair Week
- Attend at least two-thirds of monthly meetings
- Submit at least one entry in the 2026 Fair (all exhibit types accepted)
- Make an appearance at two Big Knob Grange functions annually
- Participate in parades with the Big Knob Grange Fair
- Follow the Junior Fair Board Dress Code
- Follow the Big Knob Grange Fair Code of Conduct

Dress Code:

When on duty, members are expected to maintain a professional and unified appearance.

Tops

- Junior Fair Board apparel

Bottoms

- Jeans without rips
- Khakis or black pants
- Shorts of appropriate length (jeans, khaki, or black)

Shoes

- Closed-toe shoes

Special Events:

For trainings, seminars, dinners, or similar events, business casual attire may be required.

Duties & Responsibilities:

- Community Outreach: School visits, presentations, parades, and fundraisers supporting the Junior Fair Board
- Event Support: Assisting with planning, set-up, clean-up, contests, and educational displays
- Leadership Development: Shadowing an adult fair board member and leading a Junior Fair Board project
- Fair Operations: Selling raffle tickets, judging vendor awards, taking photos, distributing wristbands, making announcements, and handing out ribbons
- Marketing & Promotion: Sharing creative ideas and helping promote the fair
- Team Collaboration: Working with the adult fair board to support smooth operations and strong community partnerships
