Pre-registration is encouraged to enhance the registration process

1. In selecting vegetables for exhibition, choose specimens that would bring the highest market price. Do not select the largest, select the medium sized specimens. If possible, do not mix varieties.
2. The following factors are generally used by an expert vegetable judge:
  - a. Trueness to variety type, all specimens from only one variety
  - b. Uniformity in shape, size, and color
  - c. Be sure to pick out a perfect specimen then select others as much like it as possible. Never mix specimens of different maturity.
  - d. Select specimens that are perfect, free from dirt, disease, infection, mechanical damage, or any blemishes
  - e. Be sure specimens are of high quality, condition, and maturity
  - f. Potatoes should NOT be washed, remove dirt with soft cloth or brush
  - g. Tomatoes should have the stems removed.
  - h. Carrots, Beets, Rutabagas, Turnips, etc. should have the tops (leaves) removed leaving about 2 in stems.
3. Entries will be disqualified for incorrect number of specimens
4. Small Labels or Stamps are time saving in filling out entry tags
