

Fruits and Nuts

Entry Times: 2 pm – 4:30 pm and 5:30 pm – 8 pm

1. All fruits should be uniform in size, color, and shape. Extreme size is not as important as uniformity
2. Free from blemishes, insect injury, and disease
3. Do not remove stems
4. Do not polish apples
5. Nuts must be from the previous year's growing season, except for peanuts
6. Some nuts will be cracked by the judges
7. Entries will be disqualified for incorrect number of specimens
8. Small labels or stamps are time saving in filling out entry tags
