File the Horse Entry Form before August 10, 2026

Directions:

1. Read “Health Rules” (Page 2) prior to sending in “Entry Form” (Page 3). **All exhibits must have the appropriate paperwork before being unloaded at the fairgrounds. NO EXCEPTIONS!**
2. Complete and Sign “Entry Form” (Page 3)
3. Mail **ONLY** Page 3 to: **Drew Haney**

4. Stalls will be awarded on a first come first serve basis, subsequent to the postmarked date on the envelope once received. A confirmation letter will be mailed to acknowledge your form has been received, at which time your stalls will be confirmed or you will be notified of your place in the event a waiting list occurs.
5. Individual Entries: One form may be submitted if you are exhibiting more than one horse. **Notice* That does not automatically guarantee you multiple stalls.*
6. Group Entries: A form must be completed for **each horse**, but they may be mailed in at the same time. **Notice* submitting multiple forms does not automatically guarantee each person a stall. If we do not have enough stalls available upon receiving the group mailing it will be up to your group to determine who the stalls are awarded to.*
7. Individuals in Groups: You may mail all of your groups forms in at the same time, or separately. Indicate that you are stalled together on the group line of the entry form. **Notice* Being part of a group does not guarantee each person a stall. If we receive the Individual entry form that is related to a group - that individual will be awarded stalls on the first come, first serve basis and will take priority based on the postmark date of the envelope. If we do not receive the rest of the group’s forms prior to a waiting list starting the remainder of the group will be added to the waiting list. If stalls open it will then be on the group to decide who gets stalls and who does not.*
8. Show forms are attached for your convenience. **DO NOT MAIL THEM.** Bring them with you to the Dept. Meeting on Monday evening. Show forms must be turned in no later than Tuesday evening to be eligible for participation.
9. Each exhibitor must sign the bottom of their own form. A parent or guardian must also sign for those under the age of 18.

HEALTH RULES FOR EQUINES

- 1. A Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) issued after May 1, 2026, is required.**
- 2. All animals must be free of infectious and contagious diseases.**
- 3. The Exhibitor's signature on the Livestock Entry Form affirms that a veterinary-client- patient relationship is in place.**
- 4. All equine animals must test **negative for EIA (Coggins) by an official test within 12 months prior to the opening date of the exhibition.**** Laboratory test results must accompany each animal to its final destination (a copy of the original lab report is acceptable). Foals less than six months of age, accompanied by a dam which meets the above requirements, are exempt from EIA (Coggins) testing requirements. If the foal is not accompanied by the dam, a copy of the dam's test results must accompany the foal to its final destination.
- 5. A current rabies vaccination** administered by a licensed veterinarian is required for animals three months of age and older. However, if a mare was currently vaccinated against rabies when she foaled, the foal is not required to be vaccinated until six months of age, with a second vaccination administered two to four weeks later. All vaccine label directions must be followed, and all rabies vaccinated equine animals must be accompanied by a rabies vaccination certificate or the vaccination information must be included on the CVI. The certificate must contain legible name and contact information of the veterinarian who administered the vaccine and the veterinarian's signature. A copy of the original rabies vaccination certificate is acceptable.

FOR OUT OF STATE HORSES - PLEASE CALL DREW FOR REQUIREMENTS.

Exhibitors must have documentation of CVI, COGGINS, and RABIES with them prior to unloading horses at the fairgrounds. A member of the horse dept will check you in – YOU MAY NOT UNLOAD PRIOR

Copies will need to be kept on file – Bring copies not originals

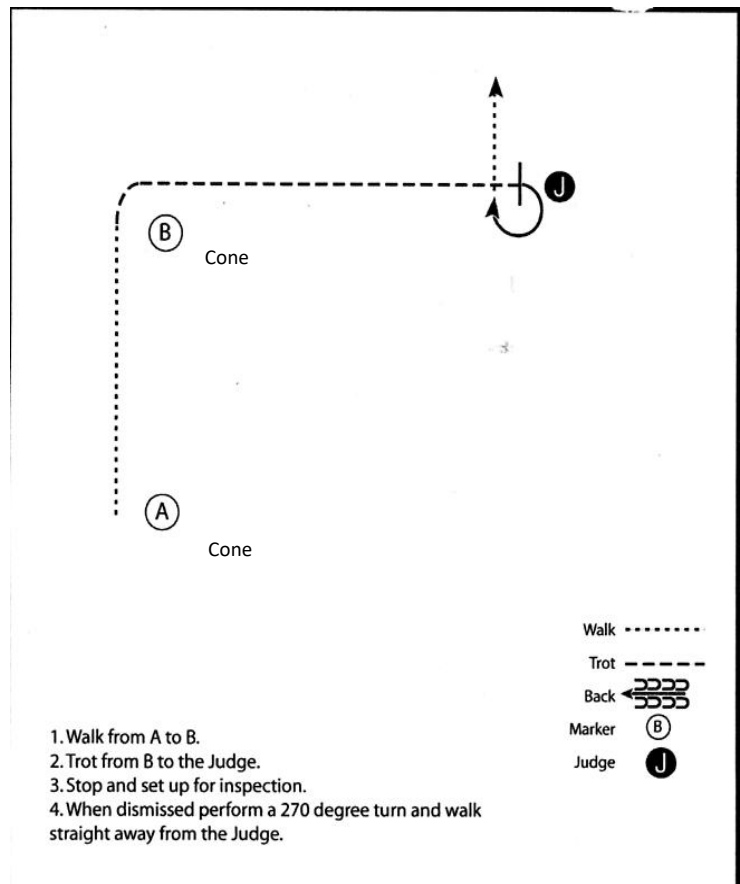
